Spring Realty LLC Chapter 40B Project 13-15 Ramsdell Way Discussion on changes for Dormers

Attorney Ted Regnante is representing the applicant, Said Abuzahra and is before the Board to discuss a minor modification/change in the dormer construction and a modification to allow four buildings rather than three buildings to be built at a time at 13-15 Ramsdell Way Project. Also attending the meeting is Peter Sandorse, architect for this project, he explains to the Board that the reason for the change in the dormers is due to problems with snow and ice buildup on the gable, he has plan showing the requested changes that was given to the Board.

Attorney Ted Regnante also made a second request on behalf of the applicant, asking for a modification of the Comprehensive Permit to allow four buildings rather than the three previously allowed to be built on spec at any given time. There will be no change in locations of the buildings, at this time there are six buildings left in Phase 11, with a total of 40 units at time of completion of the project.
