Town Hall

1. Narcan
2. Safe Station – Outreach & Alternative for residents
3. Mock Car Crash at High School
4. Drop Boxes – for Both drugs and sharps
5. Paramedics teach in Schools
6. Develop partnerships for Treatment

Police

1. Narcan
2. Drug Drop Boxes twice yearly (not enough)
3. Safe Station
4. Referrals for Residents with issues – Treatment
5. Youth/Drug Diversion Program – DA's Office
