Whereas, a certain Historic Preservation Restriction dated as of June 13, 2017 (the "Restriction") with respect to real property known and numbered 567 Main Street, Lynnfield, Massachusetts (the "Premises"), by and between Steven A. Migliero, Jr. and Kelly T. Whereas, at a meeting held on March 22, 2017 the Commission voted to approve the Changes; and

Whereas, the Grantors are relying on the said approval in purchasing the Premises;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the recitals set forth above, and notwithstanding any provision of the Restriction to the contrary, the Commission hereby certifies that the Grantors are and shall be authorized to make and construct the Changes as set forth above and as detailed and delineated in the drawings prepared by Cummings Architects included in Section 2 of the Grantors' proposal submitted in response to the RFP.
