### ATHLETIC AND RECREATION FACILITIES NEEDS SURVEY SUMMARY REPORT TOWN OF LYNNFIELD, MA

#### **BACKGROUND**

One of the keys to the development of a comprehensive recreation needs assessment for the Town of Lynnfield is to assess the perceptions of community stakeholders relative to the recreation services, programs, and facilities available to them. In order to complete such an assessment, Gale prepared, distributed, and analyzed a recreation needs survey and conducted two (2) sensing sessions with various recreation stake holders.

#### NEEDS SURVEY SUMMARY

In the web-based survey, residents of the Town were asked to complete a Lynnfield Athletic Field and Recreational Facilities Questionnaire. The website link was posted on Town websites, emailed to residents, and distributed as a hard copy to the Library and Senior Center. A complete copy of this questionnaire is provided as *Enclosure 1*. A total of 417 survey responses were received.

Below is a summary of the survey responses followed by conclusions.

Question 1 - Please enter your email address.

#### Question 2 - Are you a resident of Lynnfield?

Out of the 416 respondents, 98.3% (409) indicated that they are a resident of Lynnfield.

#### Question 3 - Age group of person(s) completing this survey:

76.3% of respondents are between the age of 40 and 59. The second largest group of respondents was between the ages of 19 and 39. As is typical with the online survey responses, only 5.8% included those over the age of 60.

### Question 4 – How many children under the age of 18 are currently living in your household?

The most common responses (60%) indicated that either two (2) or three (3) children reside in the household of the survey participant.

## Question 5 – What informal recreational activities/ facilities do you or your family participate in or attend within the Town of Lynnfield?

Out of the options provided (see survey results), the highest numbers for current recreational uses within the Town were for the following:

- Walking (83%)
- Biking (62%)
- Playgrounds (61%)
- Running (57%)
- Basketball Courts (51%)
- Golf (47%)
- Ice Skating (Pillings Pond or backyard rinks) (41%)
- Dog Parks / Dog Walking (38%)
- Swimming (34%)
- Fishing (27%)

Based on the above results, it appears that the Town provides a broad spectrum of informal recreational activities that are being taken advantage of by residents. Given the high level of participation in biking, running, and walking, it can be concluded that multi-use trails for these activities may be well attended if provided in a central location.

Question 5 also provided an "Other" category for which the participants could write-in a response. The majority of the write-in responses were for active recreation, most commonly football, soccer, baseball, and softball. While these do provide insight into recreational activities that are currently participated in within the Town, the intent of the question was to provide insight into the informal and more passive types of recreation.

# Question 6 – Which type of informal recreational needs/opportunities do you feel are currently unmet or underdeveloped in the Town of Lynnfield?

Out of the options provided (see survey results), the highest numbers for unmet informal recreational uses within the Town were for the following:

- Biking Paths (72%)
- Walking Paths (60%)
- Running Trails (48%)
- Hiking Paths (40%)
- Dog Parks (40%)
- Ice Skating (40%)
- Pools / Spray Parks (34%)

- Picnic Areas (28%)
- Swimming (26%)
- Fitness Course (25%)

As concluded in the Question 5 results, there is an apparent and substantial need for areas where biking, walking, running, and hiking opportunities can be provided. Of the highest rated responses, five (5) of the recreational activities are uses that can be accomplished by means of a multi-use trail/path network. Additionally, a need for biking paths was the most compelling response. While the development of a recreational facility could potentially include paths or single track trails, the indicated need did not distinguish between road biking and trail biking. Clearly, implementation of a road biking network with signage and marked routes would require an initiative beyond the development of a single recreation facility parcel.

Of the remaining highest rated responses, dog parks, ice skating, swimming opportunities, and picnic areas were among the selections.


Question 6 also provided an "Other" category for which the participants could write-in a response. Similar to question 5, the majority of the write-in responses were for active recreation opportunities. The most common responses were for soccer fields and softball and baseball diamonds. While Question 6 was intended to provide insight into needs related to passive recreation, it is apparent that there is an unmet need for additional athletic fields.

### Question 7 – What organized outdoor recreational activities do you or your family members participate in?

The most common response to Question 7 was "Town Recreation sponsored sports" at 70%, with "Youth sports not sponsored by the Town" (53%) and "Middle School sports" (38%) following. While the question is somewhat related to youth and children's sports, about a quarter of respondents indicated that they participate in adult sports. The results of Question 7 indicate that Town sponsored sports achieve the highest participation levels.


### Question 8 – In general, what is your perception of the CONDITION and SERVICEABILITY of athletic fields throughout the town?

The results of Question 8 indicate that about half of the respondents feel that the fields are "Generally well maintained, safe, and in condition", while the other half feels that they are in "Generally marginal condition, barely acceptable/usable". While it is difficult to gain an understanding of the reasons behind these responses, it can be concluded that in general, users feel that the fields are "Fair to Good" as they relate to the condition and serviceability.



## Question 9 – In general, what is your perception of the ADEQUACY and AVAILABILITY of athletic fields throughout the town?

The results of Question 9 are compelling and indicate that the athletic fields are "Generally insufficient in number and type to meet needs". The responses to Question 8 and 9 tell us that, while users feel that the fields are generally in adequate condition, it is clear that there is a significant lack of fields, in both number and type.




Question 10 – If you responded that there were insufficient athletic fields within the Town, indicate how many additional fields you feel the Town requires to meet program needs.

While the responses to Question 10 are widespread, there is one clear conclusion; there is a perception that additional multipurpose rectangular fields are desired. Over half of participants indicated that either one to two (1-2) or three to four (3-4) additional multipurpose rectangular fields are needed. Additionally, another third of participants feel that additional 60-foot diamonds are required. These perceptions are well-aligned with the planning program as defined by user demand, indicating that the quantity of rectangular fields is significantly low as compared to the apparent demand. However, analysis of demand provides the conclusion that additional 60-foot diamonds are not required, which is not in agreement with the survey respondents perceptions.

# Question 11 – One of the ways to improve field condition and availability is the use of infilled synthetic turf. In general, what is your opinion about the possible installation of a synthetic turf field?

The options provided as a response to Question 11 were "strongly in favor," "somewhat in favor if it is the best option to meet field needs," "somewhat opposed," "strongly opposed," and "no opinion." Out of the 413 people who responded to Question 11, an overwhelming 70% were either "strongly in favor" or "somewhat in favor." Approximately 19% of respondents were either "somewhat opposed" or "strongly opposed" to installation of infilled synthetic turf, and 9% had no opinion. This provides a strong sense that although there may be some opposition if the Town was to pursue installation of synthetic turf, the strong majority of those who responded to the survey indicated that they would be in favor. The results of Question 11 indicate that there would likely be an overwhelming support for synthetic turf fields if it proves to be a solution to better meet the recreational needs in the Town.




### Question 12 – If opposed to a potential synthetic turf field, what are your primary concerns?

The results of Question 12 indicate that, of those opposed, the reason for the opposition is well balanced over turf expense, alleged health and environmental risks, and field type preference. While the opposition to synthetic turf is minimal, there would clearly be a need for educating the public on perceived issues with its installation.

Question 13 – One of the ways to extend the use of existing fields is to provide athletic field lighting. The following fields are currently lighted to some extent: High School Football Practice Field, Newhall Field. In general, what is your opinion about the possible installation of additional athletic lighting at any of the currently unlit facilities?

The options provided as a response to Question 13 were "strongly in favor," "somewhat in favor if it is the best option to meet field needs," "somewhat opposed," "strongly opposed," and "no opinion." Out of the 414 people who responded to Question 13, an overwhelming 88% were either "strongly in favor" or "somewhat in favor." Approximately 9% of respondents were either "somewhat opposed" or "strongly opposed" to installation of athletic field lighting, and 9% had no opinion. This provides a strong sense that opposition to athletic field lighting will not be overwhelming, and that there is strong support for athletic field lighting. The results of Question 13 indicate that there would likely be an overwhelming support for athletic field lighting if it proves to be a solution to better meet the recreational needs in the Town.

## Question 14 – If opposed to the potential for more fields to be lighted, what are your primary concerns?

Similar to the responses to Question 12, there is no consensus on one major issue that concerns those opposed to athletic field lighting. Responses to the question were split evenly between "Too Expensive" and "I am concerned about off site impacts." Because of the strong support indicated for lighting, this question was either not answered or indicated as "Not applicable" by nearly 75% of the respondents.

# Question 15 – If you favor consideration of additional lighted fields, where do you think it/they should be installed to best serve the community?

Question 15 allowed participants to choose where they feel lighted fields should be installed, and were given the following options:

- Middle School Football Field
- High School Soccer/Lacrosse Field
- High School Baseball Field
- Middle School Baseball Field
- Jordan Park

Additionally, respondents could indicate other locations by writing in their response. The following chart displays the results, which indicate that the most popular field locations were the Middle School Football Field followed by the High School Soccer/Lacrosse field. This result provides justification that

participants feel that Multipurpose Rectangular Fields shall be lighted as a priority over lighting baseball fields.



Out of the written responses, the most popular choices were the High School Softball Field, School Tennis Courts, followed by Glen Meadow and Newhall Fields. Overall, Question 15 indicates that lighted fields shall be multipurpose, and the most preferable locations for lighted fields are at the Middle School stadium and the High School multipurpose fields.

## Question 16 - Do you feel that development of an indoor Recreation/Community/Youth Center in Lynnfield should be a priority?

Question 16 was used to gauge the interest in developing an indoor facility in Lynnfield that could potentially include space for recreation, community areas, or a youth center. While the question may not necessarily provide feedback that will be utilized in developing the new recreation parcel on Main Street, due to its focus on outdoor recreation space, the responses certainly may be helpful in future planning purposes for the Town. The following chart displays the results of Question 16, indicating that support for an indoor facility greatly outweighs those in opposition.



Question 17 – In considering possible improvements to athletic and recreational facilities in the Town of Lynnfield, what do you feel are the top 3 priorities? (For example: more walking trails, lighted fields, new track, ice skating rinks, dog parks, etc.)

To analyze the open-ended written responses, Gale totaled up all of the responses and categorized them by the general improvement that was recommended by each response. In general, there were ten to twelve (10-12) main improvements that were provided through write-in responses. For each of these, the total responses were counted and charted to gain an understanding of the perceptions of the respondents as they relate to the priority of several discrete recreational improvements.

Responses to the highest priority need resulted in three (3) very popular responses, followed by nine (9) other improvements that varied in popularity. The top three responses were as follows:

The top three responses for the 1st Priority need are:


- 1 Multipurpose Trails
- 2 More or Improved Athletic Fields
- 3 Lighted Fields

Whether the response was "walking trails," "biking paths," "biking trails," "running trails," or "fitness trails," these answers were combined into a general category of "Multipurpose Trails." The responses for Multipurpose Trails totaled approximately 30% of responses.

Another popular response was for "additional fields," "more fields," "better playing fields," etc. This response was categorized as "More or Improved Athletic Fields." These responses totaled approximately 23% of total responses.

The third most popular response was for lighted athletic fields and accounted for 17% of responses.

Following the top three responses, in order of popularity, were Ice Skating Rink, Synthetic Turf, Indoor Recreation Facility, and Dog Parks.




Similarly, the results of the **2<sup>nd</sup> Priority need** resulted in the following three (3) most popular responses:

- 1 Lighted Fields
- 2 Multipurpose Trails
- 3 More or Improved Athletic Fields

Following the top three responses, in order of popularity, were Synthetic Turf, Ice Skating Rink, Dog Parks, and Indoor Rec Facility.


The following chart shows the responses to the question on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Priority need:



The results of the **3rd Priority need** resulted in the following four (4) most popular responses:


- 1 Multipurpose Trails
- $2-Lighted\ Fields$
- 3 More or Improved Athletic Fields
- 4 Ice Skating Rink

Following the top responses, in order of popularity were Dog Parks, Indoor Rec Facility, and New/Improved Playgrounds.



While analyzing the results by looking at each Priority Response provides an indication of the most popular responses to each question, the more accurate analysis is to combine the responses to the first, second, and third priorities to determine the actual most noted responses. This analysis provides the following result and is the most conclusive summary to the question of the highest priority needs within the Town of Lynnfield.

- 1 Multipurpose Trails
- 2 Lighted Fields
- 3 More or Improved Athletic Fields
- 4 Ice Skating Rink
- 5 Indoor Rec Facility
- 6 Dog Parks



Question 18 - Please provide any additional comments or suggestions you may have for the improvement of recreational facilities and opportunities in the Town of Lynnfield. What would you like to see in Lynnfield that is currently unavailable?

Because the question is so open-ended, the responses to Question 18 range in topic and opinion. While it is difficult to chart the responses by type due to the variety, the following is a summary of topics that appear to be popular in response:

- A need for lighted fields
- Concern for abutter impacts
- Environmental concerns (clear-cutting, habitats, etc.)
- Fiscal constraints/raising taxes
- The need for a centralized development
- A need for dog parks
- Maintenance concerns
- Additional playgrounds
- Parking constraints
- Demand for open space/conservation/ sitting areas
- Concessions/restrooms at recreation facilities
- Demand for multipurpose trails
- Desire to have a town ice skating rink

#### CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

With over 400 responses, the Lynnfield Athletic Field and Recreation Facilities Survey provides valuable insight into the perceptions of the various recreational constituencies and stake holders. These conclusions may be somewhat skewed however, given the narrow demographics of the participants, with over 93% being adults, with only token participation by school age children, teenagers, young adults or elders.

The survey assessed attitudes, opinions and priorities in a number of different ways, and from question to question the trends, and hence the conclusions, were fairly consistent. As a result, we believe there is strong consensus, at least within the sampled age group, in the following conclusions:

1. The most important perceived recreational need throughout the Town of Lynnfield is for additional multipurpose trails for walking, biking, running, hiking, and fitness. In response to several questions concerning current unmet recreation needs and potential priorities for development, consensus reveals that trails and paths for multipurpose use is an unmet

need. It is recommended that a multipurpose trail/path network be considered as part of any new recreational park development. Additionally, the Town should look into renovation and possible expansion of existing trail facilities.

- 2. The second most important recreational need throughout the Town is for additional lighted playing fields, specifically for multipurpose use. The existing population of fields is inadequate to effectively meet current demands. It is recognized by an overwhelming majority of survey respondents that lights, allowing for extended use of existing fields may mitigate the shortage, however turf quality will suffer as increased play is accommodated on lighted, already overtaxed fields. In response to the field shortage, based on survey results, there is a widely held opinion that additional fields may be appropriate and supported at the existing high school game field. While additional fields and lighted fields were indicated as a priority for development, synthetic turf was only responded to moderately well. Based on the results indicating an overall support for synthetic turf, we feel that incorporation of synthetic turf shall only be considered in the event that field demands require the all-weather synthetic surface in order to meet field demand and allow the Town to maintain the rest of the field inventory.
- 3. While not as strong as the consensus related to multipurpose trails, lighted fields, and additional field space, there is a strong demand in the community for development of a public ice-skating facility. As a response to all questions related to unmet demand or priority needs, development of an ice skating rink was a popular response. While this type of facility may not be in the immediate planning program, the Town should consider this input and possibly research the need to obtain more feedback and reach a larger population of the Town to justify the apparent demand.
- 5. It is apparent through both survey responses and results of the sensing sessions, that maintenance and upkeep of athletic fields and parks is often not sufficient and appears to be affecting serviceability of the Town's field inventory. In response to the open ended responses, there is an apparent perception that maintenance was required, rather than new or improved facilities. Based on the demand placed on the field inventory, it is nearly impossible to provide maintenance that will sustain the level of use currently placed on the fields. A more sufficient quantity of fields, as well as a consistent maintenance regimen, will allow for more adequate and available playing fields.
- 5. Throughout the survey, the need for an indoor recreation facility often received a significant number of responses in support. The comments related to the development noted that a teen center, community building, or indoor recreation space would be well-supported. While this may not

be in the immediate planning program, this need should be further researched to reach a larger population of the Town to justify the apparent demand.

6. It appears that there would be moderate support for development of a dog park. Because it is a fairly inexpensive facility that requires minimal maintenance efforts, we recommend that incorporation of a dog park shall be considered in the development of a new recreation facility.

The Athletic Field and Recreational Facilities Survey allows us to validate our conclusions in terms of recreational needs by assessing the perceptions of recreation users as compared to what the demand quantification results tell us. The next step in the Recreational Master Plan process is to determine the extent of the unmet needs and provide schematic solutions in the way of repair and redevelopment strategies, redistribution of demand, and recreational program enhancements better meet the needs of the recreation users in the Town of Lynnfield.


