How Do I Dispose of my Christmas Tree?

The Town of Lynnfield does not pick up Christmas trees. However, residents can schedule a pick up by the Lynnfield/Wakefield Swim Team during designated weekends. This is a fundraiser for the Swim Team and all fees to pick up trees go to support the Swim Team. Generally speaking, pick up is scheduled for two weekends following the observed Christmas holiday, and payment must be received in advance of pick-up dates. Trees must be free of ornaments, lights, and any other decorations, NOT in plastic tree bags, and must be outside ready for pick up by 8:00am. Alternatively, residents may bring their Christmas trees to the DPW Yard for disposal at no charge. However, a Yard Waste sticker is required for disposal. The Yard Waste center is only open on 1 or 2 Saturdays at this time. Please call the DPW office at (781) 334-9500 for details.
