Wills stated the issue of maintenance vs. construction is no one has established the road has been finished and if it was finished it would be released. Faria stated if they don't do anything we do not have to recommend acceptance at town meeting. Board discussed with a tri-partite the money is there, with a bonding company it is not, and if the Board can no longer accept bond for security.
