

Lynnfield Recreational Path Committee

Community Update

In June 2018, the Lynnfield Recreational Path Committee published its first Community Update since the inception of this group by the Lynnfield Board of Selectmen in early 2017 to highlight the reports published and public events that have been held. The Committee received questions earlier in 2018 related to the MBTA lease document for the Wakefield Lynnfield Railroad Corridor. While the document had been reviewed by the Committee a legal subcommittee was established to further research the document. The goal of providing responses back to the Community more rapidly has led to the committee establishing a Frequently Asked Questions document that is posted on the above page as well. Topics included here summarize items covered in longer published documents, as well as questions received from the community in past committee meetings.
