The Essex County Greenbelt Association (Greenbelt) is a 501c3 land trust with offices in Essex, MA. Our mission is to protect land of scenic, ecological, and agricultural importance throughout Essex County. In 2021, Greenbelt acquired the 20-acre Lynnfield Woodlots located along Main Street in Lynnfield. This conservation project was completed with support from the town of Lynnfield, resulting in a Conservation Restriction held by the Town. The property was acquired for the purposes of protecting watershed resources and wildlife habitat, and to create public access for passive recreation. The conservation restriction held by Lynnfield allows Greenbelt to construct a 6-vehicle parking area.

Greenbelt is seeking permission from the town of Lynnfield to remove approximately 18 trees associated with the public way known as Main Street. The breakdown of tree species is roughly 10 white pine and 8 red oak. They varied in size between 6-24 inch DBH. The reason for the approximate number is the exact location of the public way boundary.

The purpose of requesting tree removal from a public way in Lynnfield is to allow the construction of a six-vehicle public access parking area as shown on the attached plan titled: "DRAFT - Parking Area and Visitor Access, Lynnfield Woods dated 4/18/2023 prepared by D. C. MacRitchie, LLC". In order to achieve sufficient grades to allow for compliant sight lines for safe public access and egress, tree removal and grading is required within the public way and on the Greenbelt land.

Greenbelt would contract with a professional tree service to complete the tree removal. All the wood would be removed from the site, except for some wood chips that would be used to stabilize trails. All stumps and excavated soils will be removed from the site as by a professional land excavation contractor.
