#### Introduction:

The subject property is located in southcentral Lynnfield just north of King Rail Golf Course. The property abuts Ready Meadow to the south, and is otherwise bordered by residential properties along Summer Street. The property is currently undeveloped and predominantly wooded aside from an 8' wide path that cuts through the center of the property. There is an existing single family home on the 385 Summer Street parcel, which slopes towards Reedy Meadow as well. Topographically, the site generally slopes north to south and towards Reedy Meadow. A drumlin formation exists on the southernmost portion of the lot, which also coincides with the highest point on the subject parcel. The property is located within the Residential (RA) zoning district.

According to the NRCS Web Soil Survey, soils within the subject lot are mapped as 52A, Freetown muck and 306C, Paxton fine sandy loam. Portions of the property are mapped as Priority Habitats of Rare Species by the Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program, however it is not located within an Area of Critical Environmental Concern.

#### **Jurisdictional Resource Areas:**

#### **Bordering Land Subject to Flooding (Zone AE):**

There is a 100 year FEMA Zone AE, (Elevation 73 – NAVD88), which extends onto the subject property according to Community Panel 25009C0393F, dated July 3, 2012. The resource area is shown on the accompanying plan at its corresponding elevation on the subject property.

### **Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW):**

#### A-series:

This resource area was delineated in the field, and is shown on the accompanying plan as the "A-series". Wetland flags A1-A10 delineate this resource area. This resource area is an extension of the BVW associated with Reedy Meadow and extends towards the backyard of 385 Summer Street. Much of this BVW occurs within existing maintained lawn, thus the delineation was primarily based on the presence of hydric soils.

#### **B-series:**

The B-series (B-1-B50) BVW flags extend westerly from the A-1 wetland flag and wrap around the entirety of the remaining parcel of land adjacent to 385 Summer Street. This BVW generally follows a similar topographic level around the perimeter of the



property. The B-series wetland borders on Reedy Meadow entirely, and contains well defined wetland vegetation and indicators of hydrology.

#### **C-series:**

The C-series (C1-C11) BVW borders on an existing pond beyond the termination of Reed Road and is defined by wetland vegetation and the presence of hydric soils bordering the edge of pond.

#### **Isolated Vegetated Wetlands (IVW):**

#### **D-series:**

The D-series (D1-D7) IVW is a small depression towards the center of the subject parcel, which is defined by the presence of a few indicators of hydrology and wetland vegetation.


#### **E-series:**

Just south of the D-series IVW, exists another IVW, which is identified as the E-series (E1-E6). Similar to the D-series, this area appears to obtain most of its hydrology due to a small depression. Hydric soils and a predominance of wetland vegetation were present within this area.






