PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING PETITION FOR JOINT OR IDENTICAL POLE LOCATIONS

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Lynnfield will hold a public hearing at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 8, 2019, in the Al Merritt Media and Cultural Center, 600 Market Street, on the following petition:

In accordance with Chapter 166, Section 22 of the General Laws of Massachusetts, and upon petition from the Verizon New England, Inc. and Reading Municipal Light Company request permission to locate poles, wires, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other sustaining and protective fixtures, along, under and across the following public way or ways:

Highland Avenue: Place one joint-owned pole, P.14, on the easterly side of Highland Avenue to a point approximately 49 feet northeasterly from existing pole, P.13.

The petitioners also request that they be granted joint or identical locations for and permission to erect and maintain poles, wires, cables and fixtures, including the necessary anchors, guys and other sustaining and protective fixtures as they may find necessary, said poles to be erected substantially in accordance with the plan filed with the Board of Selectmen and marked VZ N.E. Inc. Plan No.1A3RNOF Dated July 26, 2019.

Also for permission to lay and maintain underground laterals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and building as each of said petitioners may desire for distributing purposes.
