

### PROJECT NARRATIVE and RIVERFRONT ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS TO ACCOMPANY THE NOTICE OF INTENT FOR ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, FLETCHER ROAD AND TIMBERHILL LANE, LYNNFIELD, MA MAY 27, 2021

The proposed project consists of improvements and modifications on Fletcher Road and Timberhill Lane where Hawkes Brook, a perennial stream crosses under the roadways. The proposed work as follows:

### FLETCHER ROAD

- Replacement of the existing deteriorated 30" cmp culvert at Fletcher Road with a new 30" reinforced concrete culvert pipe.
- Adding a new 12" reinforced concrete culvert at Fletcher Road,
- Providing stone riprap aprons and slope protection at both the upstream and downstream sides of the culverts.
- Replacement of the existing water main in Fletcher Road with a new ductile iron water main.

### TIMBERHILL LANE

- Removal of a headwall and portion of the existing twin 36" culverts and lengthening of the stream channel to improve the flow characteristics of the culverts.
- Adding a new 12" reinforced concrete culvert at Timberhill Lane.
- Providing stone riprap aprons and slope protection at both the upstream and downstream sides of the culverts.

The proposed work is identified as a limited project under the MA Wetlands Protection Act Regulations (see 310 CMR 10.24 b (water line work) and 310 CMR 10.24 c1 (roadway maintenance)). Most of the proposed work will occur in the existing developed roadways. Minor portions of the work at Fletched Road will occur outside of the existing roadways (headwall repair and expansion and riprap aprons). At Timberhill Lane much of the work will occur in the roadway, however a portion of the new pipe and riprap at the upstream end and the culvert removal and stream channel expansion at the downstream end will occur outside the roadway. Work outside the roadways will be in Town owned easements or, at Timberhill Lane, on a Town owned parcel.

Wetland Resources in the project area are as follows:

- Land Under Waterway or Waterbody this is the actual area under Hawkes Brook.
- Bank this is the Bank of Hawked Brook.

- Bordering Land Subject to Flooding the area adjacent to Hawkes Brook below the 100 year flood elevation.
- Riverfront this is the area 200 feet from Hawkes Brook.
- Buffer Zone this is the area 100 feet from the Bank of Hawkes Brook.

It should be noted that Hawkes Brook has been identified in previous filings before the Conservation Commission as a perennial stream from a point below Carpenter Road, just upstream from Salem Street. Hawkes Brook is also identified as an Outstanding Resource Water as the brook is tributary to the City of Lynn water supply.

The culvert work on the project will be undertaken during periods of low flow to reduce any impacts on the resource. Erosion controls in the form of silt sacks in all catch basins proximate to the work, straw bale erosion checks in appropriate locations as the work proceeds and silt curtains in the brook downstream of the work will be employed.

The impacts of the work on the wetland resource areas have been minimized to the extent possible and are generally at the upstream and downstream ends of the culverts for riprap work to stabilize the stream channel and the sloped bank. The impacts of the proposed culvert changes on the hydrology and hydraulics of the stream are detailed in the Table attached to the Stormwater Report. The changes have been carefully considered to provide some improvement to flooding conditions in the area while minimizing downstream impacts.

It should also be noted that as a municipal project the work is exempt from the Town of Lynnfield Wetlands Bylaw and Regulations.

### **RIVERFRONT ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS**

As stated a small portion of the work will occur in the Riverfront Area and the proposed work is a Limited Project. Due to the location of the actual work, there are no alternatives to the proposed work except for the No Build option. The work in the Riverfront Area is for stabilization to enable the existing waterway and slopes to be stable during storm events, therefore we believe that the Riverfront Standard for the project to improve existing conditiond has been met.




