Thank you in advance for your kind consideration of the following:

My family is hopeful that we can pursue our wish to have a tree planted in my dad's honor. Hank Lowey was a resident of Lynnfield for over 50 years. My dad left us in November of 2014. He contributed in many ways and gave back to his community over the years. Perhaps many of your colleagues knew my dad and can speak of his fine character.

One of my dad's favorite places was Pillings Pond. Initially, our hope was to have a bench and plaque added in his honor. I was told back in November, 2014 that no more benches were possible in the Pillings Pond area so we went to plan B and have been corresponding with Jane since then regarding planting a Red Maple, *Acer rubrum* tree facing Summer Street by the benches at Pillings Pond. Our wish is to have something tasteful and appropriate in size for the surrounding area. As I am communicating with Jane long distance from California, I am also working with Kevin O'Connor at Reading Trophy and Mark Reed at Olde New England Granite to try to coordinate a small and tasteful cast bronze plaque that would say something to the tune of . . .

"Dedicated in tribute to Hank Lowey at his favorite Lynnfield spot, Pillings Pond, with love from his adoring family." (We would have a small image of an American Flag in bronze at the end of this sentence as well). My dad was proudly patriotic and loved the USA and loved the Town of Lynnfield.

In order to mount this plaque on a surface that will deter theft and be tasteful, we were considering a boulder or piece of granite to affix the plaque. We are flexible and would like this to be modest and tasteful - just like my dad. We would like to work with you and with the help of Jane to bring this family wish to fruition.

Please will you let me know if you desire any additional information in order for us to proceed in working with Jane Bandini in the tree planting division for the Town of Lynnfield.
