





PROJECT NARRATIVE PROPOSED RIPRAP BANK #99 CREST ROAD LYNNFIELD, MASSACHUSETTS

May 26, 2021

Existing Conditions

The locus site is a 20,923± s.f. residential property located off of Crest Road and adjacent to Pilings Pond. This property contains a single-family house, detached garage, lawn and landscaped areas and boat dock. Vegetation along the pond bank includes a variety of upland and wetland species such as Norway maple, American basswood, multiflora rose, Phragmites, alder buckthorn, jewelweed, and Hosta. Large stones or boulders are sporadically present along the edge of the bank. This site also contains resource areas protected under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and Lynnfield Wetlands Bylaw regulations, including inland bank, land under waterbody and waterway (LUWW), and bordering land subject to flooding (BLSF -elevation 99'), as well as 100-foot buffer zones associated with the inland bank.

Existing site features are shown on the May 2021 Hayes Engineering, Inc. plan titled "Plan to Accompany Notice of Intent in Lynnfield, Mass., #99 Crest Road" and the attached site photographs.

Proposed Work

The pond bank has become eroded over the years from storms and boat wake and needs to be stabilized to protect against further erosion and property damage. Proposed stabilization activities will consist of bringing a Bobcat or excavator-type machine onto the rear lawn and placing a line of Riprap (18"-24" stones) along the 194'± length of bank and backfilling with loam as necessary to secure the stones in place. Disturbance to overhanging shrub stems and roots will be avoided as much as possible during stone placement as shown on the above-referenced plan.

A band of the invasive species, Phragmites australis (common reed), is present along the bank as noted above and its removal will be conducted as part of this project. Phragmites stems will be cut flush with the ground and treated with an aquatic herbicide such as Rodeo® as described in the attached Penn State Invasive Plant Species management fact sheet. Phragmites removal areas will be replanted at least two weeks after herbicide application with a mat-forming ground cover such (Pachysandra procumbens (non-invasive) or other species to be determined in consultation with the owner and Conservation Commission prior to start of work.

Temporary buffer zone disturbances may result from machinery and personnel access as well as the temporary storage of stones, tools, and machinery within lawn areas. All areas of bare soil resulting from this project will be loamed and seeded or otherwise stabilized. All cut and removed phragmites plant stems will be placed in garbage bags and placed in an appropriate disposal container for transport off of the site.
