Trash

- Weekly Trash must be curbside by 7 AM on day of pickup.
- No more than seven (7) 30 gallon barrels/bags OR six (6) barrels if stuffed bulk item is included.

Bulk Item

One stuffed bulk item allowed per week. (no fee or sticker required)

Acceptable Bulk Items:

Sofa, Stuffed Furniture, Mattress Desk, Table, Chair, Bed

Rugs

1 rolled and tied 9ft x 12ft per week



White Goods Collection

- Sticker Required
- White goods pickup every 3rd full week of the month on the day of regular trash collection.


